Rose Romance Quilt

Made by Sally Ablett Finished size 72" x 81" (183 x 206cm)

Please read through all the instructions before you begin.

Requirements

One Darla 10" patchwork palette (*PP5108*) One Delilah 10" patchwork palette (*PP5407*) One Tanya Whelan 5" Charm Pack (*C5465*) 70cm of white fabric 1.50cm of Delilah Paisley in blue (*5403-7*) or another print of your choice for the border

Backing and wadding 76" x 85"

Cutting

Choose 6 fabrics from the

patchwork palette set and cut each square in half diagonally once.

Re-size 32 squares to measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ". From the white fabric cut 36 x 5" x 5"

Border - from your border fabric cut 2 x 5" x $63\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2 x 5" x $72\frac{1}{2}$ " Binding - cut from the border fabric; $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x sufficient to fit all round the quilt with a small overlap.

Stitching

To achieve a sharp professional finish to your work press each seam after stitching.

1. Arrange the half square triangles in pairs to your own preference and stitch together to form six squares.

2. Arrange the small squares in fours with two white and two patterned squares in each group placed diagonally opposite each other.

3. Stitch the small squares together to form eighteen larger squares.

4. Using the picture as a guide for positioning lay out all the stitched blocks and large squares as shown.

5. Stitch the blocks and squares together in rows with seven blocks/squares in each row. There will be eight rows in total.

6. Stitch the rows together to form the quilt centre.

7. Stitch a small square to each end of the two shorter border strips, these will be the top and bottom border strips.

8. Add the border, stitching the side strips first and then the top and bottom strips.

9. Layer together the quilt top, wadding and backing fabric and quilt by hand or machine.

10. Add the binding to complete the project.
