Size

36" x 36" (91.44cm x 91.44cm)

Supplies

Rowan Classics Fabric by The Kaffe Fassett Collective
 Binding: 1/3 yd (30.48cm) Roman Glass Red;
 GP01.REDD– Cut into 4 desired binding width by width of fabric
 Backing: 1.25yd (91.44cm) Classics-Millefiore-Red
 GP92.REDD
 (344) 2.5" x 2.5" squares from the Kaffe Fassett Collective Classic Collection

Additional Requirements

Sewing Machine
 Rotary cutter/mat/plastic ruler
 Iron/pressing board
 Basic sewing supplies
 Quilt Batting 40" x 40"
 Coats® Cotton Thread

Cutting

An assortment of fabrics

Instructions

Note: Seam allowances are 1/4" (.6cm) unless stated otherwise. WOF = Width of Fabric.

Making the triangle pieces:

1. Where the red diamond meets the blue background, there are half square triangles (photo 1). To make these, make one red and one blue square. Draw a diagonal line on the back of one of them from corner to corner.
2. Place this square on top of the other, right sides together. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim away both fabrics about a quarter inch from the seam line along one side. Open the remaining triangles and you will have a square that measures 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (6.35cm x 6.35 cm). Make 20 of these.

Laying out the quilt top

1. Following the diagram arrange the square until you have a pleasing arrangement.
2. Sew the small squares into rows. Sew the rows together.

Finishing

1. Press. Layer with batting and backing.
2. Baste. Quilt as desired.
3. Trim. Bind.
