## SQUARE-JELLY QUILT

Finished size approximately 127cm x 127cm (50" x 50")



Make this quilt top from just one *Kaffe Fassett Pastels* strip roll (*J2471*), and 1m of a plain or textured cream fabric.

You will also require a backing fabric to fit.

For the wadding we recommend Quilters Dream Cotton Natural, Request weight, Twin size (reference 6110).

Please read through all the instructions before you begin, all seam allowances are included and are 1/4"

## Cutting

From Roll - open the roll and select ten fabrics for the block centres. Sew the fabrics together in five pairs and cut five  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from each strip.

cut five strips measuring  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " from each of the remaining 20 fabrics. cut 96,  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " for outer borders

Cream fabric - 20, 11/2" x 81/2" sashing

6, 1½" x 44½" sashing and side inner borders (you will need to join strips)


2, 1½" x 46½" top inner borders (you will need to join strips)

The remainder of the cream fabric to be used for binding to the width of your choice.

## Sewing

Remember to press each seam after sewing to give the best finish to your work.

- 1. The block size is 8½" square, there are 25 blocks in all and each is constructed in the same way. The quilt is intended to have a scrappy look so it's entirely up to you where each fabric goes. The diagram is a guide to how each strip is positioned within a set of blocks.
- 2. Lay out all the fabrics for each set of five blocks.
- 3. Take a centre square and add the first strip to the top but stop sewing at the halfway point.
- 4. Working clockwise, sew the right hand strip, the bottom strip and lastly the left hand strip.
- 5. Finally complete the seam on the top strip.
- 6. When all five sets of five colourways are complete lay out the blocks in rows.
- 7. Sew the blocks together in rows placing a strip of cream fabric between each block.
- 8. Now sew the rows together placing a strip of cream fabric between each row.
- 9. Inner border: sew the side strips first and then the top and bottom strips
- 10. Outer borders: sew two strips of 23, 2½" squares together and two strips of 25, 2½" squares together.
- 11. Sew a strip of 23 squares to the right and left sides of the quilt and a strip of twenty five squares to the top and bottom of the quilt.



- 12. The quilt top is now complete, layer together the quilt top, wadding and backing fabric and pin or baste as preferred.
- 13. Quilt to your own design using the fabric or block shape as your guide.
- 14. Add the binding and you're done!
